**BLUE CONTAINER/BAG** 



#### **THROW:**

- paper packaging, cardboard
- catalogs, leaflets, brochures
- newspapers and magazines
- school and office paper, printed pages
- notebooks and books
- wrapping paper
- paper bags and sacks



# DO NOT THROW:

- paper towels and used tissues
- varnished and coated paper
- greasy and dirty paper
- milk and juice cartons
- paper bags after fertilizers, cement, building materials
- wallpapers
- disposable diapers and sanitary pads
- greasy disposable packaging made of paper and disposable tableware
- clothing

# **GLASS**

**GREEN CONTAINER/BAG** 



#### **THROW:**

- bottles and jars for drinks and food (including alcohol and vegetable oils)
- glass containers after cosmetics (unless they are made of permanently combined several selective materials)



#### METAL AND PLASTICS YELLOW CONTAINER/BAG



#### **THROW:**

- opened and crushed plastic beverage bottles
- packaging for cleaning agents (washing powders), cosmetics (shampoos, toothpastes), etc.
- plastic bags, carrier bags, other
- cans of drinks, juices and canned goods
- aluminum foil
- non-ferrous metals
- caps, lids from jars
- toys (plastic toys (unless they are made of permanently combined several selective materials)



#### × DO NOT THROW:

- ceramics, pots, porcelain, crystal
- eyeglass glass
- heat-resistant glass
- bulbs, fluorescent lamps, headlights
- packaging for medicines, solvents and motor oils
- mirrors
- window and reinforced windows
- monitors and television lamps
- thermometers and syringes

## × DO NOT THROW:

- drug packaging and used medical items
- plastic food packaging
- multi-material packaging (for example milk and juice cartons)
- motor oils containers
- car parts
- used batteries
- cans of paint and varnish with contents
- sed electronics or hosuehold goods

#### BIO **BROWN CONTAINER/BAG**



#### **THROW:**

residue from kitchen products, for example fruit and vegetable waste, leftover food, tea and coffee arounds



# **OTHERS**

(REMAINING AFTER SEGREGATION)



## **THROW:**

- paper towels and used tissues
- varnished and coated paper
- areasy and dirty paper
- disposable diapers and other hygiene materials
- ceramics
- cooled ashes







# **DO NOT THROW:**

bones and animal excrement, ashes, medicines, impregnated wood, MDF boards, ground, stones and other municipal waste



### X DO NOT THROW:

recyclable paper, plastic, metal or glass, leftover food, green waste, hazardous



# GREEN

(SINGLE-FAMILY HOUSING)

#### **BLACK BAG**

- branches
- shrubs
- arasses
- leaves
- flowers sawdust
- tree bark

#### **REMEMBER:**

Containers for municipal waste should meet the requirements of the Polish PN-EN 840 NR1 (or serial numbers) standard or have the manufacturer's declaration of conformity.

Problem waste, for example used electronics or hosuehold goods, construction waste, large items e.t.c. can be returned free of charge to selective waste collection point (check www.lodz.pl/odpady)
